

Hahoe gained its name because of the Nakdong River that flows through the local village, Dongseong Village of the Pungsan Ryu clan. It is the best place to understand traditional culture, since buildings from the early Joseon Dynasty and the folk culture of Hahoe byeolsingut talnori and the firework boat festival still remain. UNESCO registered Hahoe Village as a World Heritage in 2010 due to its outstanding universal value as cultural heritage of mankind.

In recognition of its architectural beauty and outstanding universal value, it was registered as a World Heritage Site in 2019.

Bongieongsa Temple @UNESCO World Heritage



Contains Geuknakjeon Hall, the oldest wooden structure in Korea, as well as Daeungjeon Hall, Hwaeomgangdang Lecture Hall, and Gogeumdang Hall built during the Joseon Dvnastv, and serves as valuable material for architectural studies. There is a three-story stone pagoda built in the Goryeo Dynasty, buildings such as Manseru, and Yosachae, and small attached temples such as Yeongsanam and Jijoam. At the 42nd World Heritage Committee in June 2018, seven temples including Bongjeongsa were registered as UNESCO World Heritage sites under the umbrella of 'Sansa, Buddhist Mountain Monasteries in Korea'.
